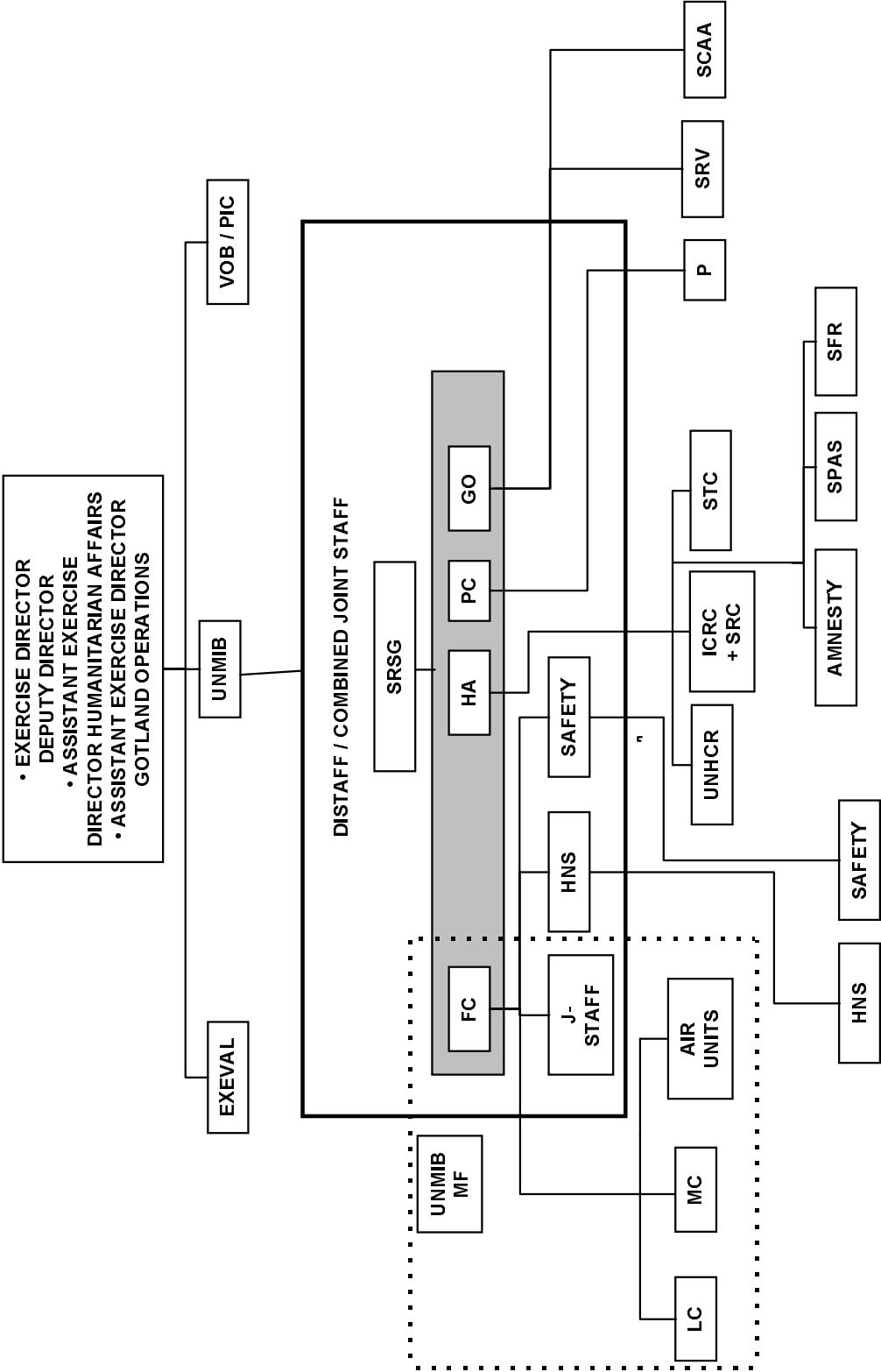

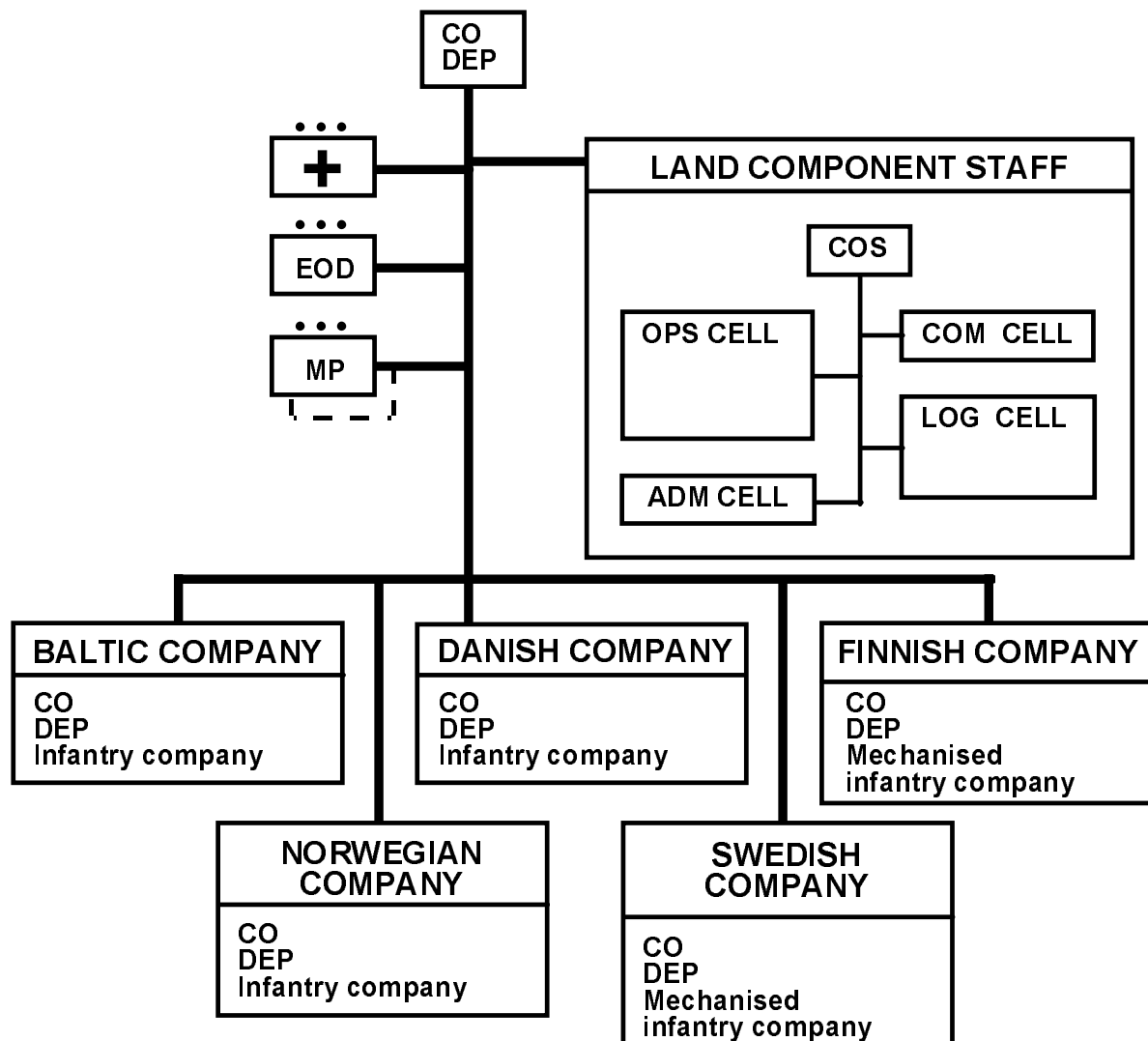

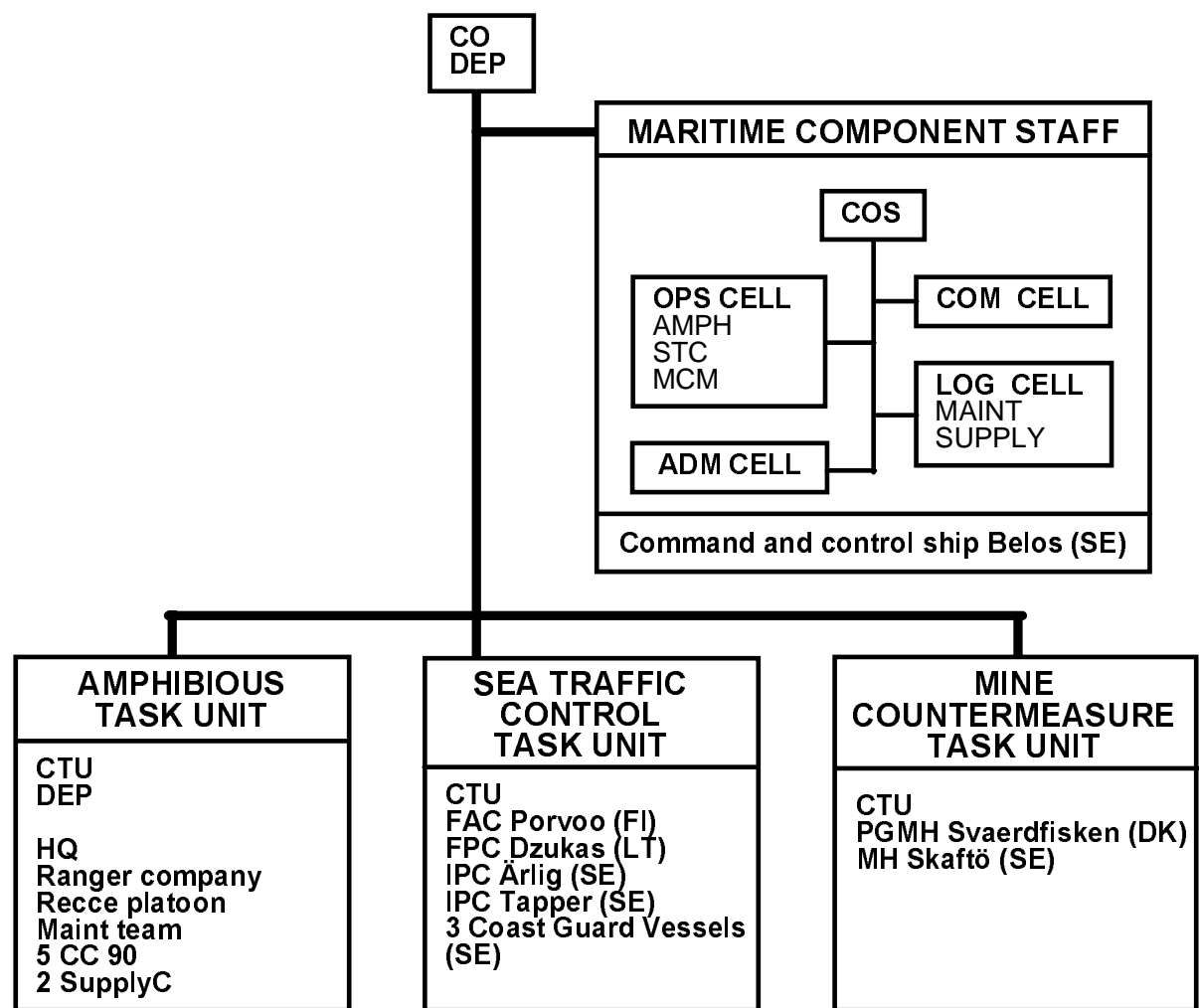
LAND TASK ORGANISATION
