

ENVIRONMENTAL SUPPORT

In order to protect environment and water supplies from damage or pollution, following rules must be obeyed by all units.

General precautions

Efforts should be taken to avoid harm on domestic and wild animals.

a) Drinking water reservoirs

Some lakes and rivers are water supplies. These are restricted areas and marked with red dashes and a "V" on manoeuvre maps.

Bivouacking, use of vehicles and helicopters are out of bounds closer than 200 meters from such areas.

Extra care should be taken to avoid pollution in these areas.

Pollution of lakes and streams is absolutely forbidden.

b) Garbage

Units are responsible for taking care of all kind of garbage in a proper way.

All garbage, e.g, tins, plastic, paper etc have to be collected in plastic bags and brought to designated waste disposal or collection point.

Under no circumstances garbage is to be left on the ground or buried in the terrain.

Garbage bags will be provided by HNS from SWEDINT and MKG.

c) Human waste

Human waste shall be kept separated from other kinds of waste.

Latrine bags have to be closed properly and transported to designated human waste disposal or collection point.

Cardboard box latrines and biodegradable bags are to be used and will be distributed by SWEDINT and MKG. Drugged latrines are forbidden.

d) Battery waste

Worn out batteries must be collected in separate cans or boxes, marked "Used batteries".

Boxes will be distributed by HNS.

e) POL-waste

All POL waste must be collected and delivered at fixed military installations.
